We also have a specialist children and family worker and a separate two bedroom house where residents are able to rebuild relationships with their children, whilst remaining fully supported.

**Bennett House** is a residential centre for adult men who have become alcohol dependent and see abstinence as a positive way forward. Accommodation comprises 8 spacious single bedrooms, communal facilities and 7 self-contained flats where residents can receive ongoing support as they prepare to move into their own accommodation. Services include structured group programmes, individual key-worker sessions, independent living skills, social and recreational activities, educational opportunities and outreach support for ex-residents.
